This is a reminder about our school expectations, particularly for Years 3&4 when dropping off in the morning. Please take your child inside the school gates, do not drop off outside. We have seen children from Y3&4 walking away from the WR site before the morning bell. Some Y6 (and maybe Y5) do have permission from parent/carers to come to school by themselves. We would expect you to wait with your child and supervise them again before the bell. However we do understand that sometimes you might need to get off quickly so make sure your child knows to go to the adult who is usually on duty if they need anything and remind them that they are not to leave the playground. Also, we would not expect children from Y3&4 to walk from the top gate on Worrall Road to the bottom main gate by themselves. Thank you for your support and keeping our children safe.
