Everyone else in my child's class has a phone	This is why this movement is SO important. We can change the culture.
We're living apart and my child needs a smartphone to communicate	Children can communicate with each parent on a simple phone and use an iPad for Facetime calls if required.
But my child needs a smartphone for train tickets and bus tickets	You can still buy tickets in person.
I need a smartphone to track my child	You can use an air tag (or similar) to track your child.
Can't we just use a stripped back iPhone with parental controls?	You can, but most parental control settings are easy to bypass.
